Cinema Debate Evening Facing up to sexual abuse of children

with the screening of a film by MONTXO ARMENDÁRIZ DONT BE AFRAID (%o Tengas Miedo)

In Europe, about 1 in 5 children are victims of some form of sexual violence. In the majority

of cases, the abuser is somebody the child knows. It is estimated that only 10% of these cases are reported. Breaking the silence surrounding sexual violence is paramount to preventing abuse, protecting children and combating impunity. The famous Spanish film director, Montxo Armendariz, brings this complex social reality to the big screen in his latest film "No tengas miedo" ("Don't be afraid") – a reality which is at the heart of the Council of Europe ONE in FIVE Campaign to stop sexual violence against children. After the film (shown in the original Spanish with French sub-titles) there will be a debate with the film director and experts on the fight against sexual abuse of children.
