

Intercultural cities time-table 2012

The key objectives for the 2011-2012 phase of Intercultural cities are:

- To consolidate the Intercultural cities methodology by monitoring progress in pilot cities and accompanying implementation of the Intercultural integration model in new cities
- To develop an evidence base to demonstrate the benefits of the intercultural approach for urban cohesion and development
- To build pedagogical tools and enlarge the expert pool enabling a larger-scale take-up of the Intercultural city approach in the future
- To develop and test a community-driven method for defining the intercultural strategies of cities, based on the principles of results-based accountability (RBA)
