



We could also connect with individuals and experts all over the globe to discuss many issues, or to learn about conflicts in the region or around the world.

Therefore each show will have a specific topic as well as serving as a general update on the project, activities offered and means to get involved.

Our target audience is mainly comprised of students and teachers, but in general is anyone who plays a role in the educational system on the island including educators, policy makers, parents, governors and other associations.


The overall objective of the project is to use Education for a Culture of Peace as a vehicle to bring structural changes and transformation in the Cypriot society across the divide in order for a Culture of Peace to be cultivated and sustained. Promotion of the project will therefore be beneficial for the whole community on both sides of the divide.

As the project progresses, having a show on the radio will be a great way for us to promote the activities we will be doing and also provide information about our specific events. These will include theatre and sports among others, all designed to promote reconciliation. It will be an opportunity for listeners to hear from people other than the organisors who are involved in the project, such as those who will deliver training sessions, researchers who could elaborate on their findings, as well as from teachers and students who could share their experiences.

We have already had interest from students and other young people who want to be involved in the project and having a space on air would allow us to reach other young people who would greatly benefit from involvement in the project. Our show could also serve as a platform for discussions surrounding peace education in a wider context. There is scope for us to invite guest speakers who are experts in the field, which would be a wonderful educational opportunity for the community.

In addition, the shows might spark debate which might inspire other civil society actors to support not only the project, but a culture of Peace in general, in other ways. It might also give the community a chance to reflect on the educational system. Overall our show would promote the cultivation of a culture of Peace.









A collaboration between the NGO AKTI Project and Research Centre and the Technical Committee on the Environment (set up as part of the confidence building measures), the show will use the environment as a tool to build trust and cooperation between the Cypriot communities.

Emphasis will be placed on presenting and discussing issues that are current in the European and/or national environmental agenda, including proposed legislation changes, current collaborations, projects and events of an environmental interest, and progress in the ongoing peace talks, particularly as it regards the work of the Technical Committee on the Environment. Additionally, opportunities for involvement and participation will also be discussed and promoted.

Additional topics concerning civic participation and civil society, relevant to the work and projects of AKTI, will also be discussed, and could include women's leadership and participation in the peace process, the rights and obligations of EU immigrants in Cyprus among others.



The main target audience is the general public, as the show will aim to raise awareness about developments regarding the environment in Cyprus and Europe, and present them in a way that will inform the public about how they could affect them, what, if any, changes to expect, and how they can become active participants.

Both AKTI and the Technical Environmental Committee believe that the people who are usually informed about and involved in environmentally-related issues and events around Cyprus are those that work/act in related sectors. There is a lack of interest and/or awareness in the general public that can be likely linked to a lack of dissemination of information in a way that highlights the 'what's in it for me?' aspect. This show will aim to bridge this gap around Cyprus.

Moreover, through the participation of guests from the scientific, academic and civil society sectors, the show will aim to depoliticize the environment, and highlight it as a true instrument for collaboration, negotiation and peace-building.

Furthermore, we could use this show to explain to the people how they can "take matters into their own hands," what they can do to help improve the Union and our lives and encourage them to participate and get involved with what we call "Civil Society."

Finally, living in a divided country, I think we need to use everything that the EU offers us and center our efforts to find a viable solution to our problem, around European values. The show could be co-hosted by two or even three people to bring in more opinions and different experiences.

3. The benefit to the community of such a show (maximum 500 words):

I strongly believe that both communities in Cyprus will benefit from such a show. In other words, Greek Cypriots and Turkish Cypriots will benefit from it. It will be a show of anti-nationalistic rhetoric, which will focus on what unites us instead of what keeps us apart.

It can also promote the idea of organizing bicommunal actions with the tools provided to us by the EU, and this can help bring members of the two communities closer.


Finally, as I explained when describing my idea, this show will try to analyze the positive side of being an EU member state. This means that to some extent, the show will question the mainstream media and make the members of the community ask themselves questions they wouldn't come up with when listening to the already existing radio stations.
