## **Description of the work activity** (100-150 words):

Considering that football plays a great social role in these two regions, we will try to work in collaboration with their most popular teams and use their power in order to promote intercultural awareness and concern against racism, particularly among Spanish and Portuguese youngsters. For this process – understood as a way to promote Media Literacy – we will have the support of the EY Capital 2012, that is Braga.
