Background

The University on Youth and Development is an activity jointly organised by the North-South Centre of the Council of Europe, the Spanish Government (INJUVE), the European Youth Forum (YFJ), the Spanish Youth Council (CJE) and other international youth organisations.

Since its first edition in 2000, the University takes place once a year bringing together representatives of youth organisations and youth movements from all over the world who gather in the CEULAJ (Euro-Latin-American Youth Centre) to discuss, train and be trained as well as to take political action around the main issues on the global agenda.

In 2011 the University on Youth and Development will be gathering for the 12th time and therefore renewed hopes and aspirations, objectives and challenges are launched to the partners to reinforce this as the space and home of Global Youth Work and of the Global Youth Movement.

In the Framework of the *International Year of Volunteers + 10 (IYV+10) 2011* and the *European Year of Volunteering 2011*, the 12th Edition of the University on Youth and Development will be held around the promotion of volunteerism and under the

theme Youth Volunteering for Global Development, exchange of practices and discussions around the values of volunteering and its connection with active and global citizenship, human rights and fundamental freedoms, progress, solidarity, peace and security, the fulfilment of which are essential in order to achieve the Millennium Development Goals. The key role that young people and youth organization play in this process will be also emphasized.

Main Goals

- To create a political space where youth can act upon and acknowledge the role they play in Global Development.
- To initiate and encourage debate aimed at defining the role youth play in elaborating development policies and in co-operation for development initiatives.
- To facilitate a process aimed at defining and implementing projects within the field of youth.

Profile of the Joint Programme Coordinator

All applicants must comply with the following criteria:

- Be a **trainer, animator or educationalist** experienced in non formal education in the youth field.
- Have an interest in global youth work.
- Have experience in coordination of youth work and work with international and Multicultural teams.
- Have been involved in the youth movement and participation in previous editions of the University on Youth and Development (participant, volunteer, trainer, organiser)
- Have a good command of the English and Spanish. Knowledge of other languages is desirable (French, Portuguese, Arabic...).
- Excellent communication and team work.

Role of the Joint Programme Facilitator

All applicants must comply with the following criteria:

- The Coordinator will be supported by the organisers, in particular by the Programme Manager for Youth Cooperation of the North-South Centre of the Council of Europe, to ensure that the Programme is run according to the UYD objectives and the proposed content.
- Coordinate the preparation and implementation of the Joint Programme of the UYD facilitating the inputs by partners and participants
- Plan and facilitate the smooth implementation of the activities for the participants in the UYD.
- Lead the team of facilitators of the Joint Programme.
- Coordinate all the logistics with the logistics team for the Joint Programme activities.

- Work with the organising partners of the UYD and other staff supporting the Joint Programme.
- Be available from 16th to 25th September.

Selection procedure

Selection will be based on the motivation and experience of the applicants with regard to the above-mentioned criteria.

Other technical details

- The University on Youth and Development will take place in Euro-Latin-American Youth Centre (CEULAJ), in Mollina (Málaga-Spain), from 18th to 25th September.
- Travel arrangements will be made by the North-South Centre of the Council of Europe for pre-paid flight tickets.
- Board and lodging will also be provided by INJUVE at the CEULAJ.
- The Joint Programme Facilitator is expected to arrive in the 16^h September.
- The working languages of the University shall be English and Spanish.
- The Joint Programme Facilitator will receive **1200 euros** for the fulfilment of the above-mentioned tasks

Out of the result of this call it will also be selected a co-facilitator to integrate the team of the Joint Programme. The co-facilitator will receive 1000 euros for the fulfillment of her/his tasks .
