

Ms Diana-Florentina Tudorache is a Romanian national. She holds a Master of Science Degree in Child and Adolescent Mental Health, obtained at King's College, London, (United Kingdom).

Her previous work experience ranges from working in a special school as a psychopedagogue to psychologist and project officer in the International Organisation for Migration (IOM) Mission in Kosovo, where she worked on the return and reintegration programme for victims of trafficking. She also worked as an inspector for the Regional Governmental Agency for Child Protection. Ms Tudorache's main responsibilities were the provision of counselling services to trafficked women and children, the organisation and implementation of awareness sessions on trafficking (when working for the IOM) as well as the supervision of specialised institutions hosting abandoned children in need and the provision of social and psychological assistance to those children (when working for the Agency for Child Protection).

Presently, Ms Tudorache holds the position of specialised police officer – psychologist in the Romanian National Agency against Trafficking in Persons.
