One of the main objectives of the Joint Project between the European Commission and the Council of Europe against Corruption, Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing in the Republic of Moldova (MOLICO) is to provide technical assistance to the FIU (Financial Intelligence Unit) of Moldova.

Two of the key activities are the promotion of the Egmont Group standards and the improvement of the IT system in the Moldovan FIU.
