Dr Steff Nash visited the village in December 2012 (better weather than when Carol and I were there in May!) and he was able to take the first installment of the money granted by the Entraide Solidarity Association. He was also able to see what progress had been made since May when Carol and I gave an initial sum of money. (He was in Myanmar for only 24 hours, having been on the Thai Burma border delivering medical training in the refugee camps.)

It all seems to be going very well, and we now have photographs showing the brickmaking and supplies as well as the progress of the structure of the school when Steff was there.
