












Have measures been taken to implement an integrated and strategic approach to protecting children from violence?






Ratifications of the Lanzarote Convention

CoE member States having prohibited corporal punishment in the home










Have measures been taken to implement the Recommendation on policy to support positive parenting?









Have measures been undertaken to protect children from violence in schools?

Have measures been taken to implement CoE standards on the protection of the rights of ...










Have measures been undertaken to implement children's right to participation as set out in Rec(2012)2?
