### **3. *Dissemination of the Output***

The researches we conducted produced five articles for different types of media and in different languages. Two of those stories were published by the international news agency IPS News, one of which was also republished in Spanish (not translated by us).

The story produced by the IPS News Service directly reaches more than 500 newspapers and magazines, arriving at an estimated 200 million readers.

Two other stories are about to be published in Italian by the daily La Stampa. The articles will appear in the online environmental section of the newspaper. La Stampa is the fourth biggest daily in Italy with more 220 thousand readers.

Finally, online magazine Responding To Climate Change (RTCC) published our long feature, which summarizes our research and field work. RTCC is a news and analysis website focused on providing the latest updates and insight into global low carbon developments.

### **4. *Biographies of the authors***

**Elena Roda** is part-time editor at Urbano Creativo News. She's back to Como, Italy, after some studying and working experiences in Europe and the US. She also works as a freelancer for Italian daily La Stampa and other minor publications. She's team member of Climate News Mosaic, transnational journalism project.

**Anja Krieger** is a freelance journalist based in Berlin and works at the intersections of environmental, science, technology and cultural topics for German media, especially national public radio Deutschlandradio. Her academic background is a degree in Cultural Sciences (Social Sciences). Together with the international network Climate News Mosaic, a group of environmental journalists from around the globe, she experiments with a 'glocal' approach to climate reporting.

**Silvia Giannelli** is an Italian freelance journalist. She graduated in Journalism with a joint-degree at the Danish School of Journalism, Aarhus University and Amsterdam University. She corresponds from Italy for the international news agency IPS, she is also a contributor for different Italian dailies, mainly La Stampa and she recently became a freelance for the ENDS Europe news service. She published stories in English, Italian and Spanish. She is a team member of the collaborative reporting project Climate News Mosaic.
