EUROPEAN EXCHANGES OF MEDIA PRACTICES (EEMPS)

EEMPS PARTICIPANTS COMMIT :

- **To work with a European colleague** in their country for at least **5 days/4 nights** and **to work with their exchange partner** in his/her country for at least **5 days/4 nights**
- **To produce a common output** comprising of:
 1. A main output consisting of one of the following:
 - a. **Media Report**
 - i. **Written report:** max 10 pages with max 15000 characters in any language
 - ii. **Radio and TV report** max length: 3 to 12 minutes in any language
 - b. **Journalism Training Tool:** max 10 pages with max 15000 characters in English or French; a model form will be provided
 - c. **Case study:** max 10 pages with max 15000 characters in English or French
 2. A **Summary of the main output** (1500 characters) in **French or English** or both
 3. An **Exchange Report** (5000 characters) on the exchange experiences, a description of the approach used, challenges faced, recommendations on how diversity and non-discrimination have been included in the design and production process of media content.
 4. **To complete an evaluation survey** after the exchange ended
- **To send the complete output to the Council of Europe and disseminate it**
- **To allow the Council of Europe to publish the EEMPs output on the *MEDIANE* website**

FOR PARTICIPANTS ACCEPTING THESE CONDITIONS, THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE WILL:

- 1) **Provide a prepaid travel ticket** for each participant
- 2) **Provide a fixed €500 lump-sum grant** for each participant for the minimum **exchange period of 5 days/4 nights** in support to cover the living expenses
- 3) **Publish the output** on the *MEDIANE* website in English and French
