# IIIrd Ministerial Meeting

# Ankara, 9-10 July 1991

The IIIrd Conference of Ministers of the Council of Europe's Open Partial Agreement on the prevention of, protection against and organisation of relief in the event of major natural and technological disasters took place in Ankara, 9-10 July 1991. (1)

- The Ministers took note, with interest, of Turkish policy in the field of civil protection and European cooperation programmes being conducted in Turkey.
- The Ministers congratulated the various European Centres of the Open Partial Agreement on the exhibition held on the occasion of their meeting.
- 3. The Minister noted with great interest:
  - the creation in Belgium of a European Centre under the Open Partial Agreement to deal with the legislative aspects of disasters, which should be of great legal assistance to Member States and other European Centres under the Agreement;
  - the creation in Aveiro (P) of a European Centre on major industrial disasters, and the holding of an international conference on this subject in Lisbon in 1992.
- 4. On a proposal by the Greek Minister, the Ministers of the Open Partial Agreement asked that the problem of the control of nuclear installations be put on the agenda of their next Meeting.
- 5. The Ministers adopted resolutions on the following themes:
  - Follow-up to the Chernobyl nuclear accident Unanimously adopted (2)

### RESOLUTION 2

## PROTECTION OF CORAL ECO-SYSTEMS

#### The Ministers

### having regard to:

- the Saudi Authorities' request to the Executive Secretary of the Open Partial Agreement concerning problems of protection and conservation of coral eco-systems in the Gulf waters
- the Resolution on this subject adopted by the Permanent Correspondents at their meeting in Moscow on 3-5 April 1991, in which they instructed the Executive Secretary of the Open Partial Agreement, in cooperation with the European Oceanological Observatory of Monaco, to prepare a programme proposal report;

taking note, with great interest, of the proposal report (doc. AP/CAT (91) 21);

<u>noting</u> that this programme could be extended to other regions, in particular French Polynesia (problem of bleached corals)

welcoming the intention to cooperate expressed by

- the Commission of the European Communities
- UNESCO's Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC)

and in particular, the invitation of a representative of the Council of Europe's Open Partial Agreement to attend meetings organised by the IOC's Steering Committee on the Integrated Action Plan for the protection of the coastal environment.

RESOLVE to approve the proposal for a joint programme between the Principality of Monaco, France, Italy, Algeria, Malta, Saudi Arabia, the EEC and UNESCO's Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission, the programme being open to participation of other countries;

INSTRUCT the Executive Secretary of the Open Partial Agreement to prepare, for adoption at the extraordinary session of Permanent Correspondents in November 1991, an apportionment of budgetary contributions by the States and International Organisations taking part in the programme and, if urgently necessary, to take action with a view to protecting coral eco-systems, with an ad hoc budget covered by voluntary contributions.
