

There are no institutions responsible for the training of judges. However, judges constantly attend seminars on various aspects of the law.

A programme has been established and approved by the Supreme Court for the training of first instance judges. The programme focuses on the training of judges in the following fields:

Human Rights

European Union Law

Civil and Criminal Procedure

Evidence Law

Sentencing

Conduct of judges

In this respect, seminars are organised on a regular basis.

Furthermore, in cooperation with TAIEX, seminars have been organised in Cyprus on specific areas of European law (ie. Article 234 Preliminary Reference). Also, again in cooperation with TAIEX, judges attend seminars overseas.
